Our topic for this half of term is 'People who help us' and 'Pirates and Superheros'. Each week we will introduce a new story and the activities will relate to it.

We will be focussing on:

People who help us at school

People who keep us safe- Firefighters/Police officers

People who keep us healthy- Doctors/nurses/dentists

Role play as Pirates and superheroes

Next half term our topic will be 'In the Woods'

We will be focussing on:

Minibeasts

Plants found in the woods

Animals that live in the woods

Phonics

This term we will continue with our phonics programme 'Read, Write, Inc'. They will carry on learning 'Set 1' sounds in this order.

The children will be focussing on the sound rather than the letter name.

We will also be concentrating on words that rhyme- e.g cat rat mat

Writing

We will continue to develop a good pencil grip.

Children will be encouraged to write their names making sure they start with a capital letter.

We will encourage independent writing for a purpose- writing in our role play areas (a school/ a police station/ a fire station/ a doctors).

Numeracy

We will continue to focus on the numbers 1-10

Children will learn about the 2D shapes circle/square/triangle/rectangle/star and the 3D shapes sphere, cone , cube, cuboid . We will solve simple problems together e.g The teddies are having a picnic- there are 5 bears but can you help me share out the food fairly?
