Welcome back to a very busy summer term. We start the key stage one assessments with the children in May. Assessments will be carried out in small groups. It's important that children arrive at school promptly as assessments will start at 9 o'clock.



Our topic for this half term is all about the medieval times. We will be learning about The Battle of Hastings, Edward the Confessor and William the Conqueror.



In numeracy this half term we will be focusing on developing our number skills. We shall be solving problems involving addition and subtraction. Practise adding and subtracting at home. Practise naming and describing 2d and 3d shapes. Practise drawing shapes and counting sides, corners and angles. Which shapes can you find at home or when you are out and about?



Please continue to read with your child every day. They will receive a reading book each week which they will bring home to you each day. Please make comments in your child's reading record book.



Home challenges: numeracy and enquiry homework is given on a Friday and must be given in by the following Wednesday. Please encourage your child to complete this with you as it supports all the fantastic learning they have done in school!
