



Autumn Term Home Learning Activities Year 4

Choose from the following list of home learning activities to complete at home this Autumn term. Choose one task per week to complete at home. When you have completed the home learning task bring it into school to share with your teacher.

1. Research your class artist. How much does their artwork sell for? Can you find images of their art? What do you think of their artwork?
2. Find out about the Ancient Egyptians. Research an area of life that interests you and present your findings in an exciting way.
3. What is the climate like in modern Egypt? Look at some weather reports and find out when the best time of year to go on holiday is. Can you plan a family holiday? Where would you go, how much would it cost, where would you fly from?
4. Our science topic is electricity. Research all the different ways electricity is made. Can you make a model of either an electricity pylon, a wind turbine, a solar panel or a hydro-electric dam?
5. Design a board game to play with your friends.
6. After half term the science topic is sound. What can you find out about sound? Can you make a model of an ear? Can you find out about different animals and their ears and how they hear?
7. Make a questionnaire about reading and reading habits and ask three members of your family or friends these questions.
8. Visit the library and read 3 new books. Write a book review on one of the books to present to your teacher. Or, draw an illustration to match a book you have read.
9. Find out about some famous Egyptian landmarks or buildings and draw them or make models of them.
10. Write an acrostic poem about the Ancient Egyptians. Make sure you use rich and powerful vocabulary.

It is up to you to decide which home learning you would like to complete first. You might decide to choose home learning task number 7 first. Whichever you choose to do bring into class to share with your teacher. Some tasks may take you longer than a week. Tick off the tasks as you complete them.

Challenge: See if you can complete all 10 before the end of term.
